

CONTRACTUAL STABILITY IN SPORT

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Introduction

The "Catalan Sports Observatory" (CSO) is an instrument addressed to people and public and private social agents that manage and offer information on Catalan Sport as a whole.

The last study that CSO has produced "The labor market in the context of sport in Catalonia" shows the profile of the people that currently work in the sport market, in a disciplinary environment and with a noticeable increase in the last years.

The aim of this poster is to analyze and compare labor conditions of people with Sport Science Degree who works in sport market.

Methods

The method used for this study was the survey using an online questionnaire with closed answers. The sample was 1000 people from a universe of 8376 graduates since 1980, proportional sample for each academic year. (n=1000; SD=+/-3%; IC=95%).



Results

Characteristics of the main areas of labor insertion

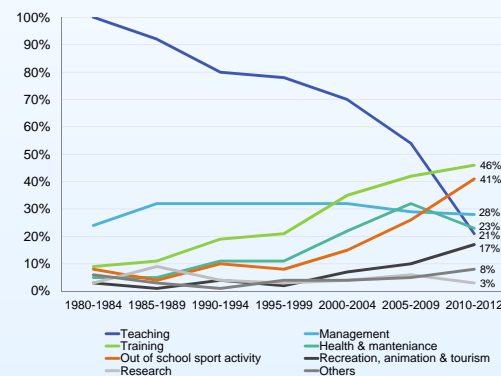
hpw work: Average hours per week

Area of labor insertion according to the year of graduation

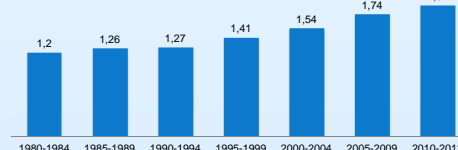
Old school years have more stable jobs while current school years have more precarious jobs.

38% of people has more than one workplace.

The average number of jobs increased in younger school years.



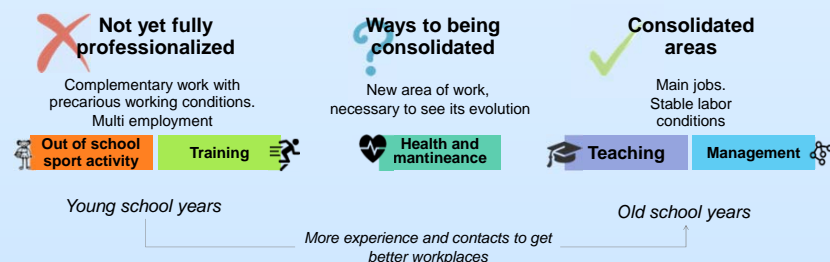
Conclusions

We can identify different groups according to the characteristics of each area of insertion.

Generally, young graduates are introduced into the labor market in the areas of training and out of school sport. These sectors are not professionalized (unstable working conditions and often as a secondary task) Consequently, multi-occupation is higher in younger promotions

As they gain experience, graduates can get jobs with better contract terms: management and teaching. These areas provide stability to be considered main job (reducing multi-occupancy).

In recent years the field of health and maintenance is growing, creating new opportunities. Working conditions currently offered are varied so that in the coming years will be possible to see which of the two sides is positioned.
